

In August 2011 Bacardi Hellas decided to relocate its head offices and thus moved into an easy accessible building-complex located in the northern suburbs of Athens. This edifice was designed to fulfill all of the company's needs and clearly reflect its identity.

"The reason why 2tec2 flooring was chosen is actually twofold. On the one hand, this innovative flooring provides high noise and sunlight absorption results to the office & common areas. In addition, its resistance to fluids and its simple maintenance procedures make it very user-friendly. On the other hand 2tec2 perfectly tied up the different materials which were used for the office and the "meet-and-talk" areas.

The office areas, as well as the meeting rooms, were constructed and equipped with modern materials, however for the bar and the kitchenette traditional materials were chosen, so as to grant a clear separation of the buildings' functions and promote the company's products.
